Dual-degrees and Joint Programs

- PSUT offers its students the opportunity to enrich their education with international experiences abroad.
- All partners are highly ranked institutions in the west.
- Most programs offer preferred tuition rates to PSUT students through our agreements (in-state tuition).
- Students also have the opportunity to apply for multiple scholarships abroad upon acceptance.
- Each program has its unique requirements for admission.

Global Direct First-Semester Support

The University of Arizona offers international online learners enrolled in the Global Direct Campus individualized attention and support, starting with admission to the University and continuing throughout their enrollment process. A unique and nurturing first-semester support model serves as the cornerstone for all Global Direct students. This includes one-on-one advising, a special community-building Student Success Course, and fun online engagement opportunities with peers from around the world. Our Academic Advisors help onboard new Global Direct students during their first semester and work with them for up to a full year, until such time as a student chooses to transition to in-person studies on our main campus or proceeds with a fully online degree. In the first semester, students take introductory math, English, and general education classes that apply toward any University of Arizona undergraduate degree. The Advisors help students move seamlessly into the best fit degree program, handling the administrative processes of choosing or changing majors or campuses.

Global Direct Online – Enrollment Options



Global Direct Online is designed to help students create a customized plan to complete a US degree. Your enrollment options include:

- TRANSITION TO MAIN This path is designed for first-time college students to earn credit online with the intention to complete the UArizona degree in person on the main campus in Tucson.
- FULLY ONLINE This path allows students to earn a full bachelor's degree online. Explore our fully online degree options!
- TRANSFER CREDIT This path allows students to take courses online with the intention to transfer that credit to another US college or university.
- THEMATIC PATHWAYS This path is designed for students who have completed 60 or more units of diverse coursework and want to apply those courses to a degree program at the University of Arizona. Through this path, you will earn your degree in General Studies completely online from UArizona's College of Humanities.
- CERTIFICATES This path is designed for students who want to enhance their educational
 experiences through a set of focused and interrelated courses in areas of interdisciplinary, global
 interest, professional need.

COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY

2+2 dual-degree B.Sc. in Computer Science / Data Science

- 1. Spend 2 years at PSUT according to a specific study plan studying Computer Science
- 2. Then Study 2 years CSU in Data Science.
- 3. Obtain two Bachelor degrees in Computer Science (PSUT) and Computer Science with concentration on Data Science (CSU).

Requirements

Minimum acceptable cumulative GPA is 70%. Minimum mark for each course is 68%. Conditions include obtaining an English language proficiency certificate TOEFL 72/IELTS 6.0 Maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 out of 4.0 in CSU to maintain the scholarship.

Approximate cost: (33% discount on tuition for PSUT vs non-resident students (per academic year and assuming 15 credit hours per semester)

Tuition Fees for non-residents (before): \$ 32,734 USD

Tuition Fees for PSUT students (33% discount): \$ 21,834 USD

Indiana University - Bloomington (IU)



2+2 Dual-degree in B.Sc. in Computer Science

Spend 2 years (60) credit hours at PSUT according to a specific study plan, then 2 years (60) credit hours at IU to obtain two Bachelor degrees in Computer Science.

- Minimum acceptable cumulative GPA is 75%. Minimum mark for each course is 68%.
- Conditions include obtaining an English language proficiency certificate.
- Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0 out of 4.0 upon graduation from IU.

Approximate cost: (In-state)

- Credit-Hour Fees: Flat Rate \$4,604.83 + Technology Fee: \$189.62 + Transportation Fee: \$64.60
- Mandatory Fees: Student Health Fee: \$116.00 + Activity Fee: \$103.41 + Repair & Rehab Fee: \$188.05
- Program Fees: \$306.00
- Total: \$5,572.51 (compare to out-of-state \$17,728.61 total fees)

Oakland University (OU)

OAKLAND UNIVERSITY...

3+2 Dual-degree in B.Sc. in Computer Engineering

Study 98 credit hours at PSUT according to a specific study plan achieving a minimum average of 70%, then study 72 credit hours at OU achieving a minimum GPA of 3.0 to obtain two Bachelor degrees in Computer Engineering.

Conditions include obtaining an English language proficiency certificate.

Approximate cost: (In state)

- Price per credit hour for Bachelor's program approximately \$ 504 (\$ 853 before discount).
- Price per credit hour for Master's program approximately \$ 680 (\$ 1,000 before discount).
- Average cost of living per semester (including housing and food): Approximately \$ 13,000.
- The cost of study materials per semester: Approximately \$ 2,000.
- The cost of health insurance per semester: approximately \$ 2,000.
- There are no quarterly fees.

UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN DEARBORN

2+2 Dual-degree in B.Sc. in Business Administration

Student studies the first 2 years at PSUT completing 70 credit hours, then studies the last 2 years at UMD completing 62 credit hours by following a specific study plan to obtain two Bachelor's degrees.

Admission requirements:

- Minimum acceptable cumulative GPA in these courses is 70%.
- English language proficiency certificate (Internet Based TOEFL 80, or IELTS 6.5, or MELAB 76)
- Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.8 in at least four high-level courses taught at UMD.

Approx. cost of studying for a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration at UMD:

Tuition fees (15 credit hours) \$ 13,962

Discount on tuition fees (for those who receive a partial scholarship) \$ 4,886

Semester service fees \$ 342



UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN DEARBORN

3+1+1 joint-degree for all PSUT Programs; B.Sc. PSUT/M.Sc. UMD For Engineering it will be (4+1+1)

- 1. Student studies all years of the undergraduate program at PSUT except for the last year
- 2. Then goes on to study the final year of the undergraduate program at UMD. Note: The fourth year may include some Master's degree courses.
- 3. Study the fifth year at UMD in the Master's program to obtain a Master's degree from UMD in one year.

Admission requirements:

- Complete min of 105 credit hours at PSUT while achieving min cumulative average of 70%.
- English language proficiency certificate (Internet Based TOEFL 84, or IELTS 6.5, or MELAB 80)
- A minimum score of 550 in the GMAT or an equivalent score in the GRE (Aptitude Exam).

Approx. cost of studying for a Master's degree in Business Administration at UMD:

- Tuition fees (9 credit hours) \$ 11,744
- Discount on tuition fees (for those who receive a partial scholarship) \$ 3,498
- Semester service fees \$ 342





3+1+1 joint degree for all programs B.Sc. PSUT/M.Sc. OU For Engineering it will be (4+1+1)

- 1. Student studies all years of the undergraduate program at PSUT except the last year.
- 2. Student goes on to study the final year at OU.
- 3. If the student is accepted to the postgraduate program at OU, 12 credit hours from the first year there will be accredited. This makes it possible to reduce the study period for the graduate program to 1 year.

Entry requirements:

- Cumulative average for courses at PSUT should be no less than 75%.
- English Proficiency Certificate (79 in TOEFL, or 6.5 in IELTS)
- Applicants for postgraduate studies do not require the GRE/GMAT examination.

Oakland University (OU)



ASAP-American Study Abroad Program

- For all Bachelor's, Master's and PhD students of all disciplines in PSUT's Schools of Business, Computing and Engineering.
- Bachelor students study min of 12 and max of 16 credit hours per semester at OU while graduate students can take min 8 and max of 12 credit hours.

Admission Requirements: (Student cannot be an American Citizenship holder.)

- Student should be in the second year of study program with a minimum average of 70%.
- Undergraduate and graduate students must obtain an English proficiency certificate, (79) TOEFL or (6.5) IELTS.

<u>Tuition fees and approximate cost of study at OU: (in-state)</u>

- For 12 credit hours in the Bachelor's program, approximately \$ 10.239, and Master's program, approx \$ 8.216.
- Average cost of living per semester (including housing and food) is approximately \$ 5,100.
- OU's health insurance plan is approximately \$ 652.
- There are no financial charges for enrolling at OU and the student pays no quarterly fees.
