

Oakland University proudly boasts one of the lowest crime rates in Oakland County and the number one safest public University in Michigan and third nationally, partially due to the many safety features in use around campus. There are over 100 blue lights all across campus, which will connect anyone directly to the OU Police Department dispatch.

They also offer text message alerts that will send a notification directly to your phone in the event of an emergency situation on campus. Students and parents are both eligible to receive these and can enroll on OUPD's website. OUPD officers are also on our campus 24/7 365 days a year.



OU is a mid-size public institution - home to over 17,000 students made up of over 13,000 undergraduate and over 3,000 graduate students. Our international students represent 64 countries from around the world.

Undergraduate class sizes have an average of 35 students in them. Outside of the classroom there are over 300 student organizations that students can be involved with.



OU offers over 140 undergraduate programs and more than 135 graduate and certificate programs.

# ASAP to Masters or 4 plus 1: Master of Business Analytics, 30 credits total

- AU students enrolled in the ASAP program, who complete the following three classes with a B or higher can count them toward the MSBA program:
  - o MIS 5140 Introduction to Database and Data Warehousing (3 credits)
  - MIS 5160 Software Program and Project Management (3 credits)
  - MIS 5460 Business Analytics (3 credits)
- If you complete these classes as part of your PSUT degree and they will transfer back, they will also count towards your Masters of Business Analytics leaving you with only 21 credits to finish or 2 or 3 semesters
- Because this degree is STEM coded you can apply for 3 years of post OAKLAND graduation work permission in the US.

#### ASAP to Masters or 4 plus 1: Engineering

- AU students enrolled in the ASAP program who are accepted to master's programs in the School of Engineering and the Master of Engineering Management may also count three ASAP classes (12 credits) toward their master's program provided that they are identified by their Oakland academic advisor in advance and the student received a B or higher.
- SO many courses you will decide with your advisors in advance.
- If you complete these classes as part of your PSUT degree and they will transfer back, they will also count towards your Masters program leaving you with only 20 credits to finish or 2 or 3 semesters
- Because this degree is STEM coded you can apply for 3 years of post graduation work permission in the US.



OU also offers many options for undergraduate students!

Students may be fully admitted based on TOEFL, IELTS or Duolingo scores. If you don't qualify right away we also offer the Global Achievements Pathways Program (GAPP) for 1 or 2 semesters depending on scores and students may begin taking academic and ESL courses at the same time.

Tuition and expenses are based on a 12-14 credit schedule per semester. Students who will enroll in summer courses should plan for additional financial support. Students should also budget an additional \$4,000 per year for books, supplies and other personal costs. Students who plan to bring dependents on an F-2 visa, should add \$6,500 (including insurance) per year for the first dependent and \$4,900 per year for each additional dependent. (A dependent is a spouse or a child 20 years of age or younger). Don't forget when talking to Canada and Mexico that they have the in state tuition differential
