My teaching philosophy is grounded in the conviction that education should be a catalyst for meaningful change- empowering students not only with technical expertise but also with the mindset and ethical grounding needed to lead with intention in an increasingly complex and interconnected world.

Over the last five years, I have driven significant advancements in language education by creating and implementing programs that directly address emerging language skills and the rapidly evolving digital landscape. In particular, I oversaw the design and launch of three courses:

- An English qualifying program for MA students
- Online English courses using Technology
- Translation course using machine translation

These courses were intentionally developed to close the gap between traditional English teaching and technology teaching tools. Each course was shaped through close collaboration with colleagues and second language teaching experts, ensuring both curricular relevance and strong language competence for graduates.
